
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Hello and thanks for taking the time to do this little interview. Can you tell us a little about yourself to help people who aren't familiar with you, get to know you a little better?

I was born in Yakutsk. It is very specific town. Temperature in a winter time can drop down to -60 C, and summer is short, hot and dry. Houses there are built not on a ground, as usual. They are raised above the ground level in pillars, like log-houses in Russian fairy tales. And winter brings so dense freezing fogs that you can't see your own stretched hand... Later I moved to Saint Petersburg, another mystical city. Here air is weaved from the water and fogs happen too, but they are not from frost. Both cities affected me very strongly.



# Where are you located? Where do you do the majority of your artwork?

I live and work in St. Petersburg. In my apartment I've created a home studio, where all my artworks went through the entire cycle from birth to completion – from the initial ideas to the printing on the canvas and then hand panting by lacquers on the canvas.

#### What do you do for a day job?

I'm a financial specialist by education, but at some point of my life I realized, that the art creation is the most important thing to me.

## What's the most important for you in life?

Love, contemplation, processes of the knowledge and thinking.






# What inspired and affected you most for being a photographer?

There is nothing particular that I could define as inspiration, muse and so on. Each case of birth of the idea or subject is unique. It could be unusual dream. It could be some amazing plant or stone on the street, or unusual face in the street train. There is no single formula...

If you had a limitless budget, what kind of personal photography project would you create?

Let's wait until I will have a limitless budget, then you'll see how I can amuse you!






# Could you reveal some of your favorite photography techniques?

I work with Photoshop. I like to use it as a tool and to experiment with the brushes.

## Can you describe your studio set-up?

There is nothing unusual in my studio – three sources of the impulse light, set of the backgrounds and photo-camera. I also have wide-format printer, which I personally use to print my canvases.









#### Can you describe what's "God" for you?

Here I would quote Mother Teresa: "I see Christ in each person. And because Christ is only one forever, then for me in given moment He is the one who stands in front of me..."





















## **The Resurrection of Beauty**

The art & philosophy of Mark Miremont

#### by Beatrice Alighieri

Mark Miremont was born in Madrid, Spain and put himself through school at Harvard and UCLA where he studied philosophy and film. His first creative works were hundreds of cryptic aphorisms which he spray-painted on the walls of Downtown Los Angeles and the Mission District in San Francisco along side other outsider artists like Joey Krebs and Robbie Conal before graffiti was held in esteem in the art world. This culminated in a sixty foot long piece on the side of The Museum of Contemporary Art's Temporary Contemporary in Los Angeles.

Running into the law doing this work led him to use film as a creative outlet, since it too allowed him to merge his philosophical ideas in a visual way. Before entering UCLA's Graduate School of Film he began directing music videos. His first video was for Soundgarden's song, Flower, which was a cross between the punk rock zine Flipside and Jean Cocteau's, Le Sang D'Un Poete. Airing regularly on MTV, the video signaled the first shots of the grunge movement.

He began making experimental films that screened with works

by Warhol and Brakhage. These, and his work in music video, caught the attention of Robert Redford's Sundance Institute while he was still in his first year of film school and he was invited to develop his first script, The White Ocean, at the prestigious June Filmmaker's Lab the same year Quinten Tarrantino developed, Reservoir Dogs.

A simple request by a band to shoot photos for an album led Miremont to pursue what he is perhaps best known for - his wildly original and perfectly composed color photography. His brash, sensual figurative work is largely responsible for the resurgence of "the pinup" and he counts as fans, not only the flocks of tattooed suicide girls, but also many of

the original pinups like the late Bettie Page and living legend, Mamie Van Doren who offers that, "Mark is blazing a trail into the future of photography."

With such a wide range of endeavors already behind him, one has to wonder what is in his future. When we met up in Toronto, I found out he is going to be a priest.

#### **ALIGHIERI**

When you were a child, did you dream about becoming an artist and philosopher?

#### **MIREMONT**

Yes. Both. Very much so. I was the kid always asking, "why?" I was always creating things, arranging things. Doodling. And no one around me understood why, as I was not brought up

in an artistic or intellectual environment. My upbringing was very blue collar, middle class, American. But I gravitated to these things, naturally.

#### **ALIGHIERI**

Have you found any answers to "why" yet?

#### **MIREMONT**

Millions of them! (laughs) I don't ask the questions anymore. Everything I do is an answer.

#### **ALIGHIERI**

Can you have an answer without a question?

#### **MIREMONT**

(laughs) That is a very strange thing to ask in an interview! That might be the best interview question ever asked, Beatrice! Do you know how profound you are being? Maybe I should be interviewing you!

#### **ALIGHIERI**

Mark, you have to stop making me laugh!

MIREMONT OK, OK. I'll be serious.

ALIGHIERI Promise?

#### **MIREMONT**

Promise. What's your best question? Go ahead. Hit me.

### **ALIGHIERI**

OK... What is art?

#### **MIREMONT**

(long pause) Art is a residue of creativity that serves no purpose.

#### **ALIGHIERI**

OK... (laughs) Really? That's what you think art is? Is that one of our aphorisms?

MIREMONT It is now! (laughs)

ALIGHIERI (laughing) Art is residue...

#### **MIREMONT**

...of creativity! That serves no purpose! Well, that's what art really is. That is just a simple fact. It may not be what art should be. There is a huge chasm between what is and what should be. But if something serves a purpose, like advertising or decoration, that's what is: an advertisement or decoration, not art. Those things too can be the product of creativity, but they serve a specific purpose. What purpose does art serve? The 20th century killed any purpose art has. The Dadaists killed it. That was, to a large extent, their aim.

ALIGHIERI
So art is dead?

#### **MIREMONT**

Well, art is dead in the same way that god is dead. It all depends on what you believe. Dadaism, like Nihilism, had its influence on 20th century culture and that is still resonating in the halls of the museums. But I see a new light shining in these first steps into the 21st century. It is illuminating a path away from the empty intellectualism that brought us deterministic physics and cynical art and into a realm where beauty is again an important part of life and culture. With my own works, I'd like to take that light and use it to resurrect beauty... To make beauty the standard of art...To make beauty the new religion.














## 50s PIN-UP QUEEN BETTIE PAGE DIES

Bettie Page, one of the most famous US pin-up models of the 1950s, has died in Los Angeles, aged 85.

Her provocative poses often in bikinis - made her a cult figure and she was one of the first models to appear in Playboy magazine.

Bettie Page was credited with helping to pave the way for the sexual revolution of the 1960s.

Some pictures of her showing bondage and spanking generated controversy and attracted a congressional subpoena.

The secretary-turnedmodel was admitted to hospital last month, suffering from pneumonia. She had a heart attack last week and never regained consciousness.

#### 'Iconic figure'

"With deep personal sadness I must announce that my dear friend and client Bettie Page passed away at 1841 this evening (0241 GMT Friday) in a Los Angeles hospital," her

agent Mark Roesler said.

"She captured the imagination of a generation with her free spirit and unabashed sensuality", he said. "She is the embodiment of beauty".

Playboy founder Hugh Hefner called her a "very dear person".

"I think that she was a remarkable lady, an iconic figure in pop culture who influenced sexuality, taste in fashion, someone who had a tremendous impact on our society," Hefner was quoted as saying.


#### Garden of Eden

#### New And Naughty

Page appeared in several burlesque films, including Teaserama, by director Irving Klaw.

Known as "The Queen of Curves" and "The Dark Angel," Page alternated between playing a stern dominatrix and a helpless victim.



#### **Corset Tales**

Page also participated in mildly risque dance routines with a well-known exotic dancer of the era, who went by the stage name Tempest Storm.

While pin-up and glamour models of the era frequently had careers measured in months, Page's signature smile and moves were in demand for years.



#### Pin-up Betty

Page starred in Varietease in 1954, which managed to challenge the sexual mores of the time without showing nudity or overtly salacious content. She stopped modeling three years later.

The 2005 biographical movie The Notorious Bettie Page, starring actress Gretchen Mol, follows the model's life from the mid-1930s through the late-1950s.



#### Glamour Girl

Page faded into obscurity in the 1960s, and later battled severe schizophrenia. However, The Rocketeer movie triggered a resurgence of Page popularity by the 1990s, and the icon maintains a significant cult following today.

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## We're all Gonna Die

The world's largest photography

Simon Hoegsberg, is a 32-year-old photographer from Denmark. (www.simonhoegsberg.com) He spent the last 17 months making this project. The photograph is 100 meters long (100 m x 78 cm), and is about the uniqueness of 'ordinary' people.

#### What's the objective of this project?

The objective was to try to reflect the warm feelings I have for strangers and for life when I see life expand and explode as I do when watching hundreds of people flying by me on the street like sympathetic fragments from a grenade. Looking at strangers through a 400 mm lens makes it apparent that every human - though very much

alive right now - is heading toward death, and it's a pretty funny fact and at the same time quite sad. It makes me aware that life is a fantastic... I'm sorry to say "gift" but I'm saying gift anyway.

### Where will the photograph be exposed?

Right now I've been given official ap-

proval to exhibit the photograph on a well visited public square in Copenhagen for 22 days in may, 2009.

## Where did you take the photographs?

All photographs were taken in the course of 20 days from the same spot on a concrete pathway leading from the center of a bridge on Warschauer Strasse in Berlin down to a platform under the bridge where the people in the picture where catching trains.

### Which were the steps to do this large photograph?

The easy part was taking the pictures. I guess I took about 3000 in the course of the 20 days I was shooting. The hard part was deciding which people

I wanted to include in the photograph. I decided to include 178 people. Why I specifically chose those 178 people and not others from the archive of portraits I'd gathered on the bridge would be a time consuming process to explain. But there's definitely a good reason. This selection process took me approximately one year. The rest was copy/paste work - cutting the people out of the original files and placing them in the 100 meter long image.

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







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
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
