

# Telephoning and electronic messaging

## Telephoning

- Hello.
- Caller** — Hello, is that Rachel Davies?
- Yes, speaking.
- Caller** — Oh, hello, it's Mark Turnbull from Print Systems here. I'm calling about the order you placed last week.
- Caller** — Hello, could I speak to Amy, please?
- Yes, of course. May I ask who's calling?
- Caller** — It's Kate.
- OK, just a minute, please...
- Caller** — Good morning. This is Alison Savage.
- Could I speak to Tina Marks, please?
- I'm afraid she's on the other line.  
Shall I ask her to call you back?
- Caller** — No, I'd like to leave a message. Could you let her know that I'll be fifteen minutes late for our meeting?
- Caller** — Good afternoon. Could I speak to Professor Dawson, please?
- I'm afraid she's away from her desk at the moment. Can I take a message?
- Caller** — Would you ask her to call me when she's back? My number is...
- Good afternoon. Planet Warehouse.  
How can I help you?
- Caller** — Could you put me through to Customer Services, please?
- Yes, hold the line please.
- Good afternoon, Customer Services.  
Shelley speaking. How may I help you?
- Caller** — Hello, I'm having trouble with the fridge I bought from you yesterday.
- Good morning. Bistro 21.  
Can I help you?
- Caller** — Good morning. I'd like to book a table for two for 8.30 on Friday please.
- Certainly. May I take your name and a contact phone number?
- Caller** — It's Blair; Mrs Blair. That's B-L-A-I-R and my daytime phone number is 02234 659920.
- Thank you madam, we look forward to seeing you on Friday.

## Electronic messaging

Text messages, chat room messages and sometimes emails can be written using the smallest number of letters possible. Pronouns, prepositions and articles may be omitted and abbreviations are widely used. These are some examples of how words might be shown in a message:
